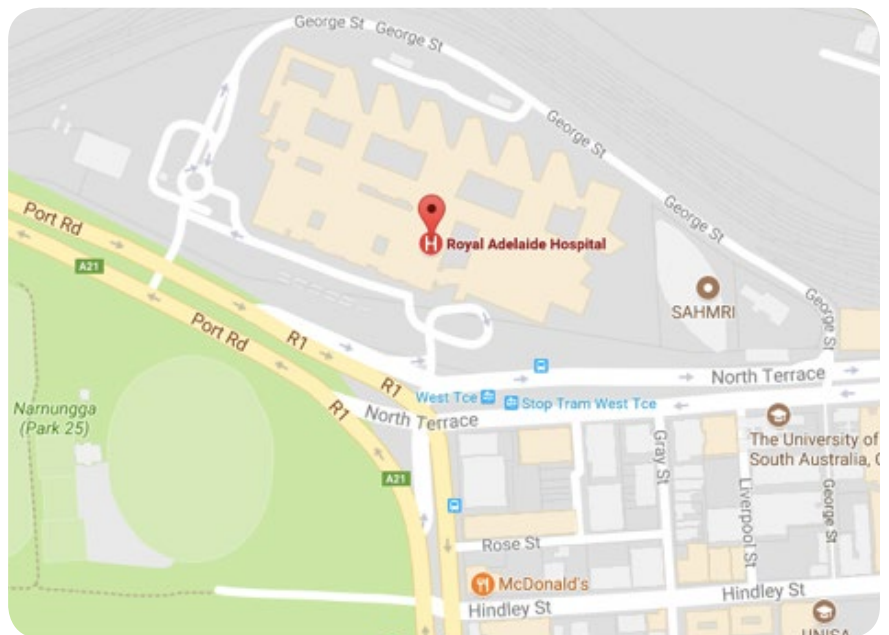
Key note speakers :

1. **Professor Susan Kurrle** is the Curran Professor in Health Care of Older People, Faculty of Medicine, University of Sydney, and the Director, NHMRC Cognitive Decline Partnership Centre. Sue will be presenting on improving outcomes for older people with cognitive impairment in hospital.
2. **Associate Professor Mark Yates** is the Director of Clinical Studies, Grampians Clinical School (Ballarat) School of Medicine, Faculty of Health Deakin University, and Geriatrician at Ballarat Health Services.
